

Directions to University at Buffalo, North Campus

If you are traveling west on the I-290 (Youngmann Expressway) take exit 5B, Millersport Highway north. When you exit onto Millersport Highway, proceed through one traffic light, pass the Maple Road exit and continue to the next exit, Flint Road, to UB's North Campus. **Turn right onto Flint Road.** See below for directions to event parking.

If you are traveling east on the I-290 (Youngmann Expressway) and wish to access UB's North Campus, be sure to exit onto the 990, which is just after the Niagara Falls Boulevard exit. Once on the 990, keep right and take Exit 1, the UB exit. Turn left at the first traffic signal, Rensch Road.

Where do I park for UBThisSummer Lectures?

From Flint Road Entrance continue along Flint Road to Augspurger Road. Turn left onto Augspurger, and then a right onto Hadley Road. The first parking lot on your right, Cooke, is free for UBThisSummer Lecture Series guests.

Parking for guests with disabilities is available in the Hochstetter A parking lot. This lot is located along Augspurger Road before Hadley. The first row is designated for parking for individuals with disabilities.

From Rensch Road Entrance continue along Rensch Road to Hadley Road. Turn right onto Hadley. The first parking lot on your left will be Cooke Lot. This lot is free for UBThisSummer Lecture guests.

Parking for guests with disabilities is available in the Hochstetter A parking lot. Continue along Hadley and turn **left** onto Augspurger Road. Turn left into the first lot, Hochstetter A. The first row is designated for parking for individuals with disabilities.
